

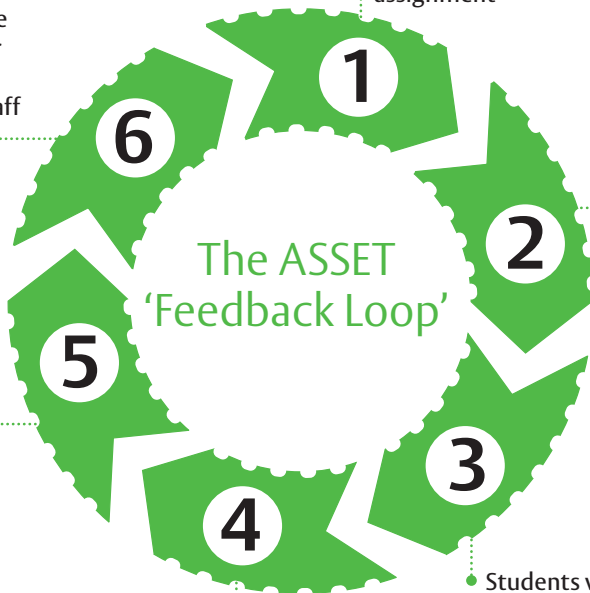


# ASSET: Moving forward through feedback

Using video to support and enhance staff and student engagement with feedback

Students view feedback video and are able to share their comments online with peers and staff (anonymously)

• Staff set coursework assignment



• Staff record a brief video to support assignment

Staff record video with feedback on assignment

Video can be used to explicitly focus on areas for improvement (*Feed-forward*)

• Students view video which can be stored in their own 'playlist'

• Students submit assignment

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## The ASSET team

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**Providing timely, quality feedback and maximising student engagement with that feedback is a considerable challenge for staff.**

**ASSET is a JISC-funded project which aims to:**

- Explore the usefulness of video media for enhancing quality and timeliness of feedback provision.
- Encourage staff to focus on *feed-forward* elements of feedback.
- Develop an interactive resource 'ASSET' which allows students to organise their feedback videos into personalised playlists.
- Facilitate feedback-oriented dialogue between students and between students and staff thereby encouraging deeper engagement with feed-forward and feedback.
- Disseminate the outcomes of the pilot study at the University of Reading across the HE sector.
