

Academic Practice Programme (APP): comprising of modules EDMAP1 and EDMAP2

EDMAP1 (Introduction to Academic Practice)

APP EDMAP1 participants will include new teaching staff on permanent or fixed term contracts of 0.5 FTE and Graduate Teaching Assistants with a contractual requirement to successfully complete the programme or modules therein. Participants may also include teaching staff on permanent or fixed terms contracts of less than 0.5FTE and other individuals with relevant teaching responsibilities

EDMAP1 is a taught 10 Credit Level 7 module and successful completion results in recognition by the HEA at D1 as Associate Fellow (AFHEA)

Possible exit point for non-contractual participants. Exit with AFHEA + 10 Level 7 Credits

Further CPD opportunities - remaining in good standing

EDMAP2 (Developing Academic Practice)

APP EDMAP2 participants will include new teaching staff on permanent or fixed term contracts of 0.5 FTE with a contractual requirement to successfully complete the programme. Participants may also include teaching staff on permanent or fixed terms contracts of less than 0.5FTE and other individuals with relevant teaching responsibilities

EDMAP2 is a taught 30 Credit Level 7 module and successful completion of EDMAP1 + EDMAP2 results in recognition by the HEA at D2 as Fellow (FHEA)

Exit point. Exit with APP: FHEA + 40 Level 7 Credits

Further CPD opportunities - remaining in good standing

EDMAP3 (Academic Research and Practice)

EDMAP3 is an optional independent module for those who wish to build on the knowledge, skills and understanding of teaching and learning developed during the successful completion of both EDMAP1 and EDMAP2

EDMAP3 is 20 Credit Level 7 module. Successful completion of all three modules EDMAP1, 2 and 3 leads to a stand-alone qualification and award of the University, the PGCAP (Postgraduate Certificate in Academic Practice)

Exit point. Exit with PGCAP + 60 Level 7 Credits
