EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE)

Food (Bacon)

ORDER, DATED AUGUST 6TH, 1941, AMENDING THE BACON (ADDITION OF BORAX) ORDER, 1940.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, as amended, and of all other powers him enabling, the Minister of Food hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1. The Bacon (Addition of Borax) Order, 1940(a) as amended(b) (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Order") shall be further amended by inserting the following Article immediately after Article 4 thereof:—
 - "4A. The provisions of Article 4 of this Order shall be suspended during the period beginning the 6th August, 1941, and ending the 15th November, 1941."
- 2.—(I) This Order shall come into force on the 6th day of August, 1941.
- (2) Copies of the Principal Order to be printed under the authority of His Majesty's Stationery Office after the date of the coming into force of this Order shall be printed in accordance with the amendments provided for by this Order and the Principal Order shall take effect as hereby amended.
