Dependant nomination form

Under the Rules of the Fund a pension may be paid to a dependant if you are not married or have a registered civil partner at the date of death. Should you be married or have a civil partner, then a pension will be payable to them and no nomination is necessary.

If you are not married or have a civil partner, you may use this form to advise the Trustees of

someone who is dependent upon you either financially or because of physical or mental disability. An example of someone who is financially dependent would be a partner with whom the household bills (such as mortgage for example) are shared. A dependant may be a same sex partner.
